BEST TIME FOR A SAFARI:

The best time to visit Kruger National Park and Southern Africa wildlife parks is from May to October. This is Dry Season, and animals congregate around waterholes and rivers. This is, in fact the low season of tourism.

- Best time: May to September. (Best game viewing months)
- High Season: June to October. (All parks)
- Low Season: April to September. (Uncrowded)
- Best Weather: April May and September October.
- Dry Weather: June to August. (Cold in the morning and at night)
- Rainy Weather: November to December. (very hot and humid with either continual rain)

PACKING FOR A SAFARI:

Southern African summers are hot and rainy. Muted colored, lightweight clothing is best for game viewing. Game drives are generally conducted in the early morning and the late afternoon, which can be cold, especially in winter. The temperature often warms up during the day, so it is best to dress in layers.
